1.1 BACHELOR OF COMMERCE HONOURS IN ACCOUNTING (4 YEARS)

1.2 BACHELOR OF COMMERCE HONOURS IN BANKING AND FINANCE (4 YEARS)

1.3 BACHELOR OF COMMERCE HONOURS IN INTERNAL AUDITING (4 YEARS)

1.4 BACHELOR OF COMMERCE HONOURS IN HUMAN RESOURCE, INDUSTRIAL & LABOUR RELATIONS MANAGEMENT (4 YEARS)

1.5 BACHELOR OF COMMERCE HONOURS IN MARKETING MANAGEMENT (4 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language and Mathematics at Grade C or better;

1.6 BACHELOR OF COMMERCE IN ACCOUNTING SPECIAL HONOURS (1 YEAR)

1.7 BACHELOR OF COMMERCE IN BANKING AND FINANCE SPECIAL HONOURS (1 YEAR)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of a relevant basic/general degree.

1.8 MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (2 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

An undergraduate degree in any discipline from this or any other recognised University.

2.0 FACULTY OF EDUCATION

2.1 DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION (PRIMARY) (3 YEARS)

Entry Requirements

To be admitted to the programme, applicants must have a minimum of five (5) Ordinary Level passes including English language, Science and Mathematics at grade C or better.

2.2 BACHELOR OF EDUCATION (SECONDARY) (Teaching Diploma or Certificate Holders: (3 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language, Mathematics and Science at grade C or better. Gained advanced standing through the accreditation of prior learning (APL) route or a diploma or certificate in Education (Early Childhood Development or Infant School Education) is an added advantage.

2.3 BACHELOR OF EDUCATION IN EARLY CHILDHOOD DEVELOPMENT (BECD) (Diploma Holders (in-service): 3 YEARS; Non-Diploma Holders or school leavers (Pre-service): 4 YEARS.

Entry Requirements

A minimum of five (5) Ordinary Level passes including English Language, Mathematics and Science at grade C or better. Gained advanced standing through the accreditation of prior learning (APL) route or a diploma or certificate in Education (Early Childhood Development or Infant School Education) is an added advantage.

2.4 BACHELOR OF EDUCATION IN EDUCATIONAL MANAGEMENT (3 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A relevant diploma or certificate in Education and 5 'O' Level passes including English Language at Grade C or better.

2.5 POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN EDUCATION (PGDE) (18 MONTHS)

Entry Requirements

Any recognised university degree.

2.6 MASTER OF EDUCATION IN EDUCATIONAL MANAGEMENT (2 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

Bachelor of Education degree with a minimum of a lower

second class pass (2.2). Any other relevant first degree with a minimum of 2.2 and some recognised experience in a management post.

3.0 FACULTY OF ARTS, CULTURE AND HERITAGE STUDIES

3.1 BACHELOR OF ARTS IN ENGLISH AND COMMUNICATION STUDIES (4 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language at Grade C or better.

3.2 BACHELOR OF ARTS SPECIAL HONOURS IN LITERATURE IN ENGLISH (1 YEAR)

Entry requirements:

Applicants must have a recognised Bachelor of Arts degree in English or any other relevant degree in which the literature in English component is strongly represented.

3.3 BACHELOR OF ARTS IN MEDIA STUDIES (4 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language at Grade C or better.

3.4 BACHELOR OF ARTS SPECIAL HONOURS IN COMMUNICATION AND MEDIA STUDIES (BASHCMS) (1 YEAR)

Entry requirements:

Applicants must have a recognised Bachelor of Arts in Media and/or Journalism studies, or any other relevant degree in which the media or journalism component is strongly represented.

3.5 BACHELOR OF ARTS IN RELIGIOUS STUDIES AND THEOLOGY (4 YEARS)

Entry Requirements

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language at Grade C or Better.

3.6 BACHELOR OF ARTS HONOURS IN ETHICS AND ORGANISATIONAL LEADERSHIP (4 YEARS)

Entry Requirements

A minimum of 5 'O' levels or their equivalent including English Language Or Gained advanced standing through the Accreditation of Prior Learning route. Relevant 'A' level certificate, other relevant certificates, teaching certificate or diploma will be an added advantage.

4.0 FACULTY OF APPLIED SOCIAL SCIENCES

4.1 DIPLOMA IN DISABILITY STUDIES (2 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes or equivalent including English Language at grade C or better. Experience in human science employment will be an added advantage.

4.2 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE HONOURS IN PSYCHOLOGY (4 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes or equivalent including English Language and Mathematics at Grade C or better.

4.3 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE HONOURS IN SPECIAL EDUCATION (4 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language at Grade C or better; Experience in Teaching, Social Work or Nursing; Recognised teaching or nursing qualification.

4.4 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE HONOURS IN RECORDS AND ARCHIVES MANAGEMENT (4 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language at Grade C or better;

4.5 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE HONOURS IN RECORDS AND ARCHIVES MANAGEMENT (2 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language at Grade C or better; AND a Higher National Diploma in Records and Archives Management

4.6 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE HONOURS IN LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SCIENCE (4 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language at Grade C or better;

4.7 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE HONOURS IN LIBRARY AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (2 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language at Grade C or better; AND a Higher National Diploma in Library and Information Science.

4.8 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE HONOURS IN DEVELOPMENT STUDIES (4 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language at Grade C or better; Experience in a human service profession will be an added advantage.

4.9 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE HONOURS IN COUNSELLING (4 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language at Grade C or better; Have a recognised professional qualification in a human service profession (e.g teaching, nursing, social work).

4.10 MASTER OF SCIENCE IN SPECIAL EDUCATION (2 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

Bachelor's degree in Special Education, Psychology, or any equivalent with a minimum of 2.2 degree classification.

4.11 MASTER OF SCIENCE IN PEACE, LEADERSHIP AND CONFLICT RESOLUTION (2 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A relevant degree with a minimum of 2.2 degree classification

4.12 MASTER OF SCIENCE IN COUNSELLING (2 YEARS)

Entry Requirements

Bachelor's degree in Counselling or Psychology with a minimum of 2.2 degree classification

4.13 MASTER OF SOCIAL SCIENCE IN DEVELOPMENT STUDIES (2 YEARS)

Entry Requirements

A minimum of a Honours degree in Development Studies or related discipline with a minimum classification of 2.2 or equivalent and a minimum period of 2 years working in a related field.

4.14 POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN DEVELOPMENT STUDIES (18 MONTHS)

Entry Requirements

A good Honours Degree in Development Studies or related disciplines from a recognised University; A good basic Degree in a related discipline.

5.0 FACULTY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

5.1 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE HONOURS IN NURSING SCIENCE (4 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English language and a Science subject at Grade C or better or their

equivalent. Applicants must also be registered with the Nurses Council of Zimbabwe.

5.2 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE HONOURS IN PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORT (4 YEARS)

Entry Requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' level passes, including English Language and a Science subject with a grade "C" or better. Or A relevant diploma/certificate or 'A' Level science passes will be an added advantage.

5.3 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN MATHEMATICS AND STATISTICS (4 YEARS)

Entry Requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including English Language and Mathematics at Grade C or better. A pass at 'A' level Mathematics or a teachers' certificate or Diploma in Education with Mathematics as a major subject will be an added advantage.

5.4 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE HONOURS IN GEOGRAPHY AND ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES (4 YEARS)

Entry requirements:

A minimum of 5 'O' Level passes including Geography, English Language and Mathematics at Grade C or better.

6.0 FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE

6.1 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE IN AGRICULTURAL MANAGEMENT (4 YEARS)

Entry Requirements:

Have at least 5 'O' level passes including English language, Mathematics and one Science subject incorporating Biology and Chemistry (e.g. Integrated Science, General Science, Agriculture or Chemistry and Biology) at Grade C or better, or a Diploma in agriculture or Certificate in agriculture or related field of study from a recognised institution.

7.0 FACULTY OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY AND MULTIMEDIA COMMUNICATION

7.1 BACHELOR OF SOFTWARE ENGINEERING (HONOURS) (4 YEARS)

7.2 BACHELOR OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (HONOURS) (4 YEARS)

7.3 BACHELOR OF SCIENCE HONOURS IN MULTIMEDIA TECHNOLOGY (4 YEARS)

A relevant Master's degree with a pass or better from a recognised university.
